

**Auburn University At Montgomery
Stormwater Management Program (SWMP)**

Auburn University At Montgomery shall develop and implement a Stormwater Management Program Plan (SWMPP) that may include but not limited to the following components.

A. Public Education and Outreach

AUM shall develop and implement a public education program to

- Educate the students and outreach into the community about the impacts of stormwater discharges on water bodies
- Identify steps that the students/community can take to reduce pollutants in stormwater runoff.

The mechanism used to educate the students/community will include but not limited to:

B. Public Involvement/Participation

AUM shall develop and implement a students/community involvement/participation program to provide opportunities for student/public input, feedback and participation. Mechanisms and activities to educate the public may include but are not limited to the following:

C. Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination

AUM shall develop, implement and enforce a program to detect and eliminate illicit discharges from entering AUM's MS4. Components of the illicit discharge detection and elimination program may include but not limited to the following:

- Develop a program and schedule to locate and screen outfalls within the MS4
- Develop procedures for evaluating potential non-stormwater discharges

D. Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control

AUM shall develop, implement and enforce a program to reduce, to the maximum extent practicable, pollutants in stormwater runoff from qualifying construction sites. Components of the construction site stormwater runoff control program may include but not limited to the following:

- Implement and enforce a program to reduce pollutants in stormwater runoff from qualifying constructions sites. Components of the construction site stormwater runoff control program may include but not limited to the following:
 - Implement a training program for site inspection staff
 - Develop procedures for **periodic inspections** of qualifying construction sites
 - Develop procedures for construction site plan review

E. Post-Construction Stormwater Management in New Development and Redevelopment

AUM shall develop, implement and enforce a program to manage stormwater runoff from new development and redevelopment sites.

Activities that may be intergrated into the post-construction stormwater management program include but may not be limited to:

- Comprehensive Plan
- Post Construction Inspection

F. Pollution Prevention/Good Housekeeping

AUM shall develop and implement a pollution prevention and good housekeeping program may include but not limited to the following:

- Develop an employee training program for staff responsible for AUM facilities and operations included in the SWMP
- Identify and implement best management practices to minimize the discharge of pollutants from municipal facilities and operations
