Scholarships and Assistantships

The AUM Department of Fine Arts offers a variety of scholarships, based partly on merit and partly on financial need. Students must major in a discipline within the Department of Fine Arts: Graphic Design, Photography, Drawing and Painting, Sculpture, Ceramics, Visual Art, or Art History. New students and current students may apply.

Merit scholarship: \$7,000.00 per academic year (2 semesters). Awarded once per academic year. Application deadline is February 28, 2018. Winners determined by the Fine Arts Department Scholarship Committee.

Half scholarship: \$3,500.00 per academic year (2 semesters.) Application deadline is February 28, 2018 for the following fall semester. Winners determined by the Fine Arts Department Scholarship Committee. Note: Students minoring in a Department of Fine Arts program may apply for a half tuition scholarship.

Studio Assistantship: \$1,200.00 per semester. Student must be nominated by an AUM faculty member. Students will assist the professor in the maintenance and upkeep of the sponsoring professor's studio (6-8 hours per week). The number of hours and the work schedule will be negotiated by the student and the sponsoring professor.

#### Other awards

Betty Hood Poorman Award: This is a one-time, \$300.00 award determined by the Department of Fine Arts Faculty each spring. The award is given to a current student in any stage of their career for outstanding achievement.
