

**MEASURES ON PROGRAM OUTCOME AND COSUMER INFORMATION:****Measure 5: Graduation rates from preparation programs**

The EPP tracks the number of candidates that matriculate and complete the programs. Students who did not complete their programs may currently be enrolled in the program, transferred to another program, withdrew from the college, or were dismissed from the program. The table below uses the following definitions:

- Program Completer is defined a program candidate that completed all graduation requirements.
- Current Enrollment is defined as the total number of candidates enrolled in the program at then end of the 2019-2020 assessment cycle that includes students that may not currently be enrolled in courses.
- Total enrollment is defined as the total number of candidates that were enrolled in the program during the assessment cycle (Program Completers + Currently Enrolled Candidates)
- The graduation percentage is defined as the number of percentage of students that graduated from the program. This percentage is not representative of a cohort but relates to the percentage calculated from program's total enrollment.
