

Auburn Montgomery Alumni Association 2019-2020 Graduate Study Merit Scholarship Application Guidelines

Scholarships are for current Auburn Montgomery graduate students.

- Student must be fully admitted to the Auburn Montgomery graduate program, must have completed at least 9 Auburn Montgomery course hours leading to a graduate degree and must have a current GPA of 3.4 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Graduate GPA, entrance exam score(s), letters of support, a 250-word essay, and current résumé will be assessed.
- Scholarships are for fall 2019 and spring 2020 only. **Application Deadline: March 15, 2019**
- Scholarships must be used for graduate tuition only and only for courses leading to a graduate degree (no undergraduate-level prerequisites or audits).
- Preference will be shown to applicants with entrance exam scores in the top 50th percentile.
- Applicants will be notified of their award status by mail.**
- Recipients are expected to join the Auburn Montgomery Alumni Association and to volunteer for alumni functions. Annual student membership is \$15.

All completed application packets must contain the following:

- Auburn Montgomery Alumni Association Graduate Study Merit Scholarship Application (below);
- Completed record release form for all transcripts, for Alumni Affairs one-time use.** This form may be included with the application packet, or may be completed in the Office of the Registrar.
- Official graduate entrance exam score(s) (GMAT, GRE, MAT); **The Alumni Office will request scores from the Office of the Registrar. Applicants do not need to include this in the packet they submit.**
- Two letters of support, preferably from Auburn Montgomery faculty or staff, emphasizing leadership skills;
- A 250 word essay outlining educational and career objectives; how this award will benefit you; and academic honors/awards and civic activities;
- A current résumé listing employment positions, dates of employment, number of hours worked, campus and/or community leadership, and academic achievements.

NOTE: It is the applicant's responsibility to obtain and submit all records by the due date. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

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Scholarship recipient must:

- maintain a GPA of 3.4 or higher on a 4.0 scale each semester the scholarship is received;
- enroll for and complete at least nine (9) hours each semester** the scholarship is received unless the recipient provides documentation of full-time employment. Students in their final semester who need fewer than nine (9) hours to graduate are exempt from this requirement;
- be continuously enrolled each semester the scholarship is received. Recipient must immediately notify the Alumni Association in writing should any or all courses be dropped for any reason. Should the recipient resign after the final drop date, the scholarship will be revoked, and the student will be held responsible for repayment of their scholarship. The only exceptions are documented, verifiable severe personal illness or call to active military duty. Any scholarship refunds will be credited back to the Auburn Montgomery Alumni Association.
