



Honors Curriculum Requirements

For incoming transfer students and those admitted to the UHP after their first semester at AUM

These are the courses students should complete in order to graduate from the University Honors Program. 27 credit hours of Honors coursework including 6 hours of thesis research and writing are required to graduate with full University Honors. The alternative Warhawk Honors pathway is explained on the reverse.

*HONR 1757 replaces ENGL 1010/1020 requirements. Students who have already met this requirement may use HONR 1757 to satisfy Area II or Area IV Core Curriculum requirements instead. HONR 1957, HONR 2757, and HONR 3757 replace any course in Area II or Area IV of the AUM Core Curriculum. **Students should take honors seminar courses that correspond to their academic year** whenever possible: HONR 1757 in the freshman year, HONR 2757 in the sophomore year, and HONR 3757 in the junior year.

**Honors Electives include additional HONR courses, departmental honors courses (e.g., BIOL 1017, COMM 1017, PHIL 2017, and other departmental courses ending with a '7'), and honors courses "by contract."



University Honors

Complete 27 hours of honors credit (including 18 hours of seminar courses: HONR 1757, HONR 2757, and HONR 3757) with a grade of 'B' or better in each course, maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.4 or higher, and successfully research and defend an honors thesis.

Warhawk Honors

Complete 21 hours of honors credit including 18 hours of seminar courses (HONR 1757, HONR 2757, and HONR 3757) with a grade of 'B' or better in each course, and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.4 or higher; no thesis required.

OR

Complete 15 hours of honors credit including nine hours "by contract" (i.e., major courses at the 3000-level or above that have been converted to honors status) with a grade of 'B' or better in each course, and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.4 or higher.

All graduates of the UHP will be recognized as such at commencement. University Honors graduates will wear a medallion and cord; Warhawk Honors graduates will wear only a cord. Every graduate of the UHP will have their honors status indicated on their transcript; University Honors graduates alone will also have this distinction noted on their diplomas.
