DID YOU KNOW?

IF YOU ARE SEXUALLY ASSAULTED...

- If the sexual assault has just happened, get to a safe place.
- Report the assault immediately.
- Request immediate medical attention.
- Do not shower, brush your teeth, use the restroom or change your clothes. You may destroy important evidence.
- If you have been assaulted or witnessed an assault, you should report the assault to the Police as soon as possible. All allegations regarding sexual assault will be investigated by Campus Police and Title IX.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS TO KEEP IN MIND ON CAMPUS AND OFF CAMPUS

- Take advantage of offered self-defense training classes.
- Make sure someone knows where you are at all times.
- Never leave campus with someone you do not know.
- Consider using your Campus Escort Service available 24/7 by calling (334) 244 - 3424.
- Watch your drink to avoid spiking. Know your drink limits. The legal age is 21.
- Listen to your instincts. Tell someone if you feel unsafe.
- Whenever possible, take a friend with you.

NO MEANS NO

Affirmative consent is a knowing, voluntary, and mutual agreement among all participants to engage in sexual activity. Consent to any sexual activity or prior consensual sexual activity between or with any party does not constitute consent to any other sexual act. Consent may be initially given but can be withdrawn at any time. Consent cannot be given when a person is incapacitated caused by a lack of consciousness or being asleep, intoxication, or physically or mentally incapable.
