To earn either Honors designation, students must

- complete the curricular requirements listed below with grades of “B” or better,
- maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.4 or better,
- complete at least 12 hours of service every semester, and
- participate in University Honors Program activities.

University Honors

The highest recognition conferred by the UHP is University Honors. Those earning University Honors complete 27 hours of requirements, which includes the Honors thesis.

Warhawk Honors

UHP students may earn Warhawk Honors, in either of the following ways:

- 1) by completing 21 semester hours of honors credit, of which at least 18 hours are honors seminar courses (HONR 1757, HONR 1857, HONR 2757, or HONR 3757) or
- 2) by completing 15 semester hours of honors credit, only for honors students in professional majors (e.g., nursing, education) with substantial practica in the junior and senior years.*

** Changes approved in spring 2021 restrict the majors who can complete the 15-semester-hour pathway. These changes apply to those entering Honors in summer 2021 or later.*

All graduates of the UHP will be recognized as such at commencement. University Honors graduates will wear a medallion and cords; Warhawk Honors graduates will wear only the honors cords. Every graduate of the UHP will have their honors status indicated on their transcripts and diplomas.
