professional development component, if available.		
Evidence of Leadership and Management Potential Form (attached)		
<u>Letter of Intent</u> (to include the following sections in your letter)		
 Describe professional and career goals and reasons for pursuing an 		
instructional leadership certificate		
 Summary of what you expect from this program 		
 Evidence of your ability to improve student achievement 		
Successfully complete an IL Interview with the IL Admissions Committee. This		
Committee is made up of AUM Faculty and P-12 Instructional Leaders. AUM Faculty		
will schedule this interview for you.
