The Blount Presidential Endowed Scholarship is established by the Blount Foundation, Inc. of Montgomery, AL. This scholarship is awarded to outstanding graduating high school seniors in the state of Alabama. Blount Presidential Scholarships shall be limited to full-time students enrolled in the pre-engineering curriculum at Auburn University at Montgomery. Pre-engineering student applicants at Auburn University at Montgomery must be committed to fields of either civil engineering or mechanical engineering. This scholarship is a one-year award totaling up to \$5,000, and may be combined with the Opportunity, Recognition, Achievement, Warhawk, Counselor, Vice Principal, Principal, and Outstanding Scholars Scholarships. This scholarship is competitive and limited in number. *This scholarship is competitive and limited in number.*

Scholarship eligibility requirements:

- First-time Freshman admission to Auburn University at Montgomery.
- Enrolled in Pre-engineering curriculum at AUM and be committed to study either civil engineering or mechanical engineering.
- 26 in ACT MATH or 620 in SAT MATH or 76 in ALEKS
- Minimum 3.0 high school grade point average.
