



Do I qualify for the Deichelmann Memorial Scholarship?

To be considered for the Deichelmann Memorial Scholarship, you must have graduated in the top ten (10) percent of your high school graduating class. An application to the AUM University Honors Program (UHP) is also required. On average, students admitted to UHP have a 26 or higher ACT score (though that is not a minimum requirement), 3.5 or higher high school GPA, and a history of rigorous academic and extracurricular participation. We encourage students who have leadership qualities (highlighted by involvement in high school and the community) and academic achievement to also apply for the Freshman Leadership Scholarship. To apply, students must be first-time, full-time incoming freshman directly from high school. This scholarship is competitive and limited in number. The application deadline is March 1.

What types of things will I do as a Deichelmann Scholar?

Deichelmann Scholars will be challenged to think creatively and critically. Students will work as a team and develop leadership skills. Deichelmann Scholars may participate in the UHP curriculum and attend symposiums, seminars, and special events. Students will also be exposed to diverse cultural experiences and develop a broader sense of global citizenship.

What are the benefits?

Deichelmann Scholars will receive priority registration, specialized classes, expanded study abroad opportunities, and Deichelmann Scholar distinction at graduation.

What do I have to do to keep the scholarship?

Deichelmann Scholars will be required to maintain a 3.4 cumulative institution GPA, full-time enrollment (12 hours minimum) each fall/spring term, and maintain good standing in their university engagement expectations. The Deichelmann Memorial Scholarship is renewable up to 4 years.

Can this scholarship be stacked with other academic scholarships?

The Deichelmann Memorial Scholarship cannot be stacked with other Freshman Merit Scholarships or institutional scholarships. However, students receiving the Out-of-State tuition discount may receive both awards.

Who is a good fit for the Deichelmann Memorial Scholarship?

Students who wish to be challenged academically, serve the AUM campus and local community, and desire to experience new opportunities are encouraged to apply.

Active participation in UHP, as your campus engagement requirement, is required if you are selected to be a Deichelmann Scholar. For more information about the University Honors Program, please visit <u>www.aum.edu/honors</u>

** To remain active in the UHP, students must maintain at least a 3.4 GPA, take at least one honors course each semester, participate in activities of the UHP including a minimum of 12 hours of service each semester, and must earn a grade of "B" or higher in any course taken for UHP credit. Members of the UHP are expected to represent AUM, the University Honors Program, and the AUM Honors Assembly in a positive manner.
