## **Application Requirements:**

### **1. Completed Online Application**

Please contact your advisor to receive a link to an Online Application and follow the direction to complete/submit the application.

You will be required to indicate:

- (1) Field laboratory school assignments you have completed prior to applying for your internship. (Include your current placement if any). **\*\* Refer to LiveText.**
- (2) Select desired school district(s) you wish to intern.
- (3) READ and UNDERSTAND the disclaimer.

### **2. PRAXIS II**

**All required tests must be passed at the time the internship application is submitted.  
No exceptions.**

- To register for **PRAXIS II** tests, visit [www.ets.org/praxis/al](http://www.ets.org/praxis/al) or call 1-800-772-9476.
- To register for **Foundations of Reading 190 test** visit [www.al.nesic.com](http://www.al.nesic.com)
- You **must** have your **PRAXIS II** scores sent to AUM, code (1036) **AND** Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE). No exceptions.
- Students are eligible to receive an edTPA voucher when eligibility is verified, pending the availability of funds.
- Internship applications will no longer be rolled over from semester to semester. If you do not intern when the application is made, you must reapply.

### **3. Initial Internship Seminar**

Regardless of your approval status, ALL internship applicants MUST attend Initial Internship Seminar. Date, Time, and Location will be notified upon application completion.
