- Secondhand smoke is the third leading cause of preventable death in the country, and has been proven to cause cancer, heart disease, stroke, emphysema and asthma.
- More than 8,500 Alabamians die each year from smoking-related illnesses.
- The Surgeon General has stated there is no safe level of exposure to secondhand smoke.
- Everyone has the right to breathe smokefree air.
- Smokefree policies are the only effective way to eliminate exposure to secondhand smoke.
- All Montgomery residents and workers deserve to breathe smokefree air in public places and workplaces including bars and restaurants.
- Each year Alabama spends approximately \$1.49 billion on healthcare cost directly caused by smoking.
- 21 Alabama municipalities have enacted and implemented comprehensive smokefree policies to protect their workers and residences.
- 30 states have enacted comprehensive statewide smokefree policies that eliminate exposure in all workplaces including bars and restaurants.
