Review your Handshake and LinkedIn profiles and add new experiences and skills.

Identify resources needed beyond graduate school (OPT requirements for international students, salary negotiation strategies, terminal degree program options, etc.).

Schedule a Career Advising appointment with the CDC to review your Career Action Plan and develop job search strategies if needed.

Attend all career fairs, on-campus recruiting sessions, and Handshake events related to your career field to grow networking skills and maximize potential opportunities.

Update resume and cover letters with new roles and experiences and submit to resumereview@aum.edu for review.
