2026-2027 Graduate Study Merit Scholarship

Application Guidelines

Scholarships are for **current** Auburn University at Montgomery graduate students.

- Student must be fully admitted to the Auburn University at Montgomery graduate program, must have completed at least 6 AUM course hours leading to a graduate degree and must have a current GPA of 3.4 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Graduate GPA, 2 letters of support, a 250-word essay, and current résumé will be assessed.
- Scholarships are for fall 2026 and spring 2027 only. **Application Deadline: April 20, 2026**
- Scholarships must be used for graduate tuition only and only for courses leading to a graduate degree (no undergraduate-level prerequisites or audits).
- This scholarship is for face-to-face academic programs only, and does not apply toward fully online programs.**
- Applicants will be notified of their award status by email.
- Recipients are expected to participate in Auburn University at Montgomery and Alumni Association functions.

All completed application packets must contain the following:

- AUM Alumni Association Graduate Study Merit Scholarship Application (below);
- Two letters of support, preferably from AUM faculty or staff, emphasizing leadership skills; **NOTE:** each faculty/staff member can write a maximum of 3 letters for this scholarship. Letters must be on official letterhead, and can be given to the student to include in their packet, or emailed directly to alumni@aum.edu.
- A 250-word essay outlining educational and career objectives; how this award will benefit you; and academic honors/awards and civic activities;
- A current résumé listing employment positions, dates of employment, number of hours worked, campus and/or community leadership, and academic achievements.

NOTE: It is the applicant's responsibility to obtain and submit all records by the due date. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

Scholarship recipient must:

- maintain a GPA of 3.4 or higher on a 4.0 scale each semester the scholarship is received;
- enroll for and complete at least six (6) hours each semester** the scholarship is received unless the recipient provides documentation of full-time employment. Students in their final semester who need fewer than six (6) hours to graduate are exempt from this requirement;
- be continuously enrolled each semester the scholarship is received. Recipient must immediately notify the Alumni Association in writing should any or all courses be dropped for any reason. Should the recipient resign after the final drop date, the scholarship will be revoked, and the student will be held responsible for repayment of their scholarship. The only exceptions are documented, verifiable severe personal illness or call to active military duty. Any scholarship refunds will be credited back to the AUM Alumni Association.
