3. Unofficial Transcript from WEBSTER showing

- ▶ 45 semester hours of coursework must be completed.
- ▶ Official Posted Grades for FNDS 2010 (FNDS 1010-AUMTeach), FNDS 2120 (FNDS 1020-AUMTeach), and FNDS 2140 with a minimum of 2.50 GPA average.
- ▶ Completion of ENGL 1010, ENGL 1020, and COMM 1010, 2100 or 2212 achieved grade of a “C” or better.
- ▶ Completion of all remedial requirements. **All Elementary, Early Childhood, and Special Education K-6 and ECE must complete** at least ONE core Math.
- ▶ Must resolve ALL failing grades. (See advisor for assistance.)
- ▶ GPA of 2.50 Over-All, and a 2.50 GPA in your Professional Studies **and** Teaching Field courses. ** It’s okay to apply if you are still taking course(s) to meet the application need in the current semester, **however you won’t be assessed until those grades are posted.**

4. Students majoring in any area of Education will NOT be allowed to take any Professional Studies OR Teaching Field Class more than twice (any course on the back of your program plan of study page 2).**5. Professional Education Faculty Admission Interview (Please see the back for instructions.)**

Each student will be required to have an interview before being admitted to professional education. Proof of completion will be needed before turning in the professional education application. Please follow the instructions listed below:

1. Students will complete the Alabama Interactive Training on Child Abuse.

 - c. Click (current year) Mandated Reporter Trainings
 - d. Click (current year) Child Abuse Mandated Reporters Training
 - e. Click Create New Account –Fill out required information
 - f. Click (current year) Child Abuse Mandated Reporters Training
 - g. There are 5 sections. Complete all sections including reading, watching videos, and taking quizzes.
 - h. When you are finished, print out your certificate of completion and email to eduadvising@aum.edu.
