

## **History Scholarships and Awards**

### **The Fair-Robinson Scholarship**

A \$1,000 scholarship open to currently enrolled undergraduate History majors with at least a 3.25 GPA in History and a 3.00 overall average. Applicants must have at least 12 semester hours of History courses above the 2000 level.

### **The Patricia Bradley Memorial Scholarship**

Created in honor of Dr. Patricia Bradley, Distinguished Teaching Professor of History at AUM from 1982 to 2002. This scholarship is open to currently enrolled History majors or students who intend to declare a History major. Applicants must have completed at least one History survey course and be currently enrolled in an additional History course. Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 in all AUM course work as determined by the School of Liberal Arts.

### **The Don Dodd History Prize**

This prize is a cash award of \$50 to the AUM undergraduate who submits the best essay on the history of the American South.

### **The Dr. Richard Evans Morse Memorial History Prize**

This prize is a cash award of \$50 to the AUM undergraduate who submits the best essay on any topic.
